*This award is given in memory of Ronald J. Curry (1904 – 1984), who was born in Haliburton, the son of Mr. and Mrs. W. R. Curry, and who owned and operated Curry Motors until his retirement. Mr. Curry served as Reeve of Dysart et al for nine years, and as County Warden. Under his leadership, the first Tourist Association was formed. He was the charter President of the Rotary Club of Haliburton, where he held a record of perfect attendance for 35 years. For some 20 years he was a member of the Haliburton County District High School Board, and served as its Chairman. He served as a member and as Chairman of the Board of Governors of Sir Sandford Fleming College for seven years. Mr. Curry was active in the Haliburton United Church and the Red Cross Society, and he was a Director of the Guild of Fine Arts. He was a charter member and ardent supporter of the Scholarship Fund and a 33<sup>rd</sup> degree Scottish Rite Mason.*

Phyllis and Clayton were married in 1921. Clayton was a Member of the Canadian House of Commons for Victoria-Haliburton from 1945 until 1963. He was a life-long participant in community affairs, and was interested in the education and advancement of the people of Haliburton County. It is hoped that this award will help our youth prepare themselves to participate in our nation's affairs.*
